<p><b>2 Matters Arising from Minutes of meeting on 23 May 2007</b></p> <p>Annie confirmed that subsequent to the meeting she has decided that she does not wish to act as chair for the group, but is keen to remain as the specialist shop representative on the group.</p> <p>The minutes of the meeting on 23 May 2007 were approved.</p>	
<p><b>3 Confirmation of Membership of the Camden Passage Working Group</b></p> <p>Lucy Arnold was elected as chair of the group and it was agreed that the vice chair would be elected when all the sectors are represented at the next meeting.</p> <p>The sectors of the working group were confirmed:  The Mall - tbc  Antiques – Lucy Arnold  The Market -Yvette Pathare  Retail – Laura Allnat, Lollipop  Specialist Shop – Annie Moss  Restaurant - tbc  Resident – Bob Borzello</p> <p>Annie confirmed that The Breakfast Club has expressed an interest in joining the group. She will approach them again and ask them to attend the next meeting.</p> <p>Christine/Karen agreed to speak to Neil Jackson, the manager of The Mall about joining the group.  It was agreed that the members of CPWG would consult with shopkeepers and traders locally and within their sectors to gauge responses to ideas of the group and to gain support.</p>	<p>AM</p> <p>CL/KM</p>

<p>It was agreed that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All decisions taken by the group would be voted upon to reach consensus.</li> <li>• The role of the Chair would be to ensure that the agreed projects are taken to fruition.</li> <li>• Angel BID Ltd will offer advice and support with businesses at the Angel, the police, the council and Transport for London.</li> <li>• Angel BID Ltd will arrange the venue for meetings and service them accordingly.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>4 Confirmation of Projects</b></p> <p>Christine confirmed that Angel BID has committed £20,000 to projects to enhance Camden Passage as a shopping area/tourist attraction. The Angel BID Board, as the accountable body, will be required to approve the projects and all finances.</p> <p>The group agreed three priorities for the year for Christine to present to the BID Board:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The reinstatement of a market on the site outside Reiss and the expansion of stalls in the Passage</b> A discussion ensued on developing the market. It was agreed that Christine and Lucy will liaise with the council on the many issues that need to be resolved (such as the purchase of stalls, storage of stalls, marking out of area electrical supplies, parking and loading/unloading, access to toilets, licensing of stalls, insurance, storage and management).</li> <li>• <b>Winter lights and a Christmas event, including a Christmas Tree outside Reiss</b> It was agreed that £5000 would be committed to this project from the CPWG allocation, subject to BID Board approval. Christine agreed to develop a proposal for the winter lights and Christmas event for presentation to the Council, Reiss and other businesses who would be approached for support. Christine confirmed that she would seek to fundraise a further £5000 for lights in the Passage</li> <li>• <b>Signs to promote Camden Passage (Essex Road end and by The Mall)</b> It was agreed that the best signs that could be afforded should be erected to promote Camden Passage. Christine pointed out that this may be subject to planning permission and agreed to approach the council.</li> </ul> <p>The group agreed that Camden Passage would be promoted/advertised when opening times of the market and shops were agreed (at the next meeting) and there is more to offer.</p> <p>Bob Borzello proposed producing a leaflet promoting Camden Passage that could be distributed through local estate agents.
